EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT CAPABILITIES ASSESSMENTS




- 1. The degree or magnitude of the escalation is inversely proportional to the level of preparedness/preparation and
- 2. The speed of escalation is inversely proportional to the timeliness of our response efforts.






